PE - In Term 1, Year 4 children will have PE on Thursdays and Fridays. Please can the children come into school dressed in their school PE kit on these days. As the colder weather is approaching, we strongly recommend tracksuit bottoms. PE kit should be the school-house coloured T-shirt and navy/ black bottoms. The short 'Nike Pro' style of shorts are not suitable for PE at school and should not be worn.

Message from the Year Group Teachers

Welcome to Year 4! What an amazing start we've had! We have been so impressed by all the children's independence when coming into school – they should all be very proud of themselves!

Please can we remind you that children should wear full PE kit to school on Thursdays and Fridays, when they have PE, but we would like them to wear their school sweater/cardigan or plain navy tracksuit top rather than tracksuit tops or hoodies with logos, etc. Please follow the link to uniform on the website. If their PE top is not available, then children can wear a school polo shirt. Please make sure that all items of clothing, etc. are named so that if they are mislaid, they can be returned to you. Can we also remind children to bring in their named water bottles and coats as the weather changes.

Please can you ensure that your child brings in their banded reading book and reading record daily as we aim to listen to children read during the school day.

A reminder from Miss Garton that from next week, Year 1 and 2 parents should please say goodbye to their children at the infant gate and let them try walking to their classrooms on their own. We will always support and adapt for any children who are really struggling. Years 3-6 children should now come through the junior gate.
