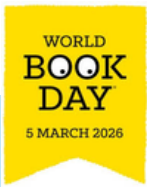
CELEBRATING TERM 3

The World Book Day Letter went out last week but here's another reminder about dressing up on the day ...

'This year is the National Year of Reading which is also our theme for the day.
